**Please note that the building itself may remain open past the Artist Alley hours for commodities such as coat check or concession to remain accessible to the attendees.*

Cost & Payment Details

Pricing subject to change pending convection costs. Please reach out to Artist Alley coordinator.

The table dimensions are 6'x30" and each table comes with two chairs and two badges. Additional badges can be purchased by contacting the Artist Alley Coordinator.

If you're wanting to share a table with a friend, it's suggested to purchase one full table and split the cost rather than both purchasing a half table as placement cannot otherwise be guaranteed.

Payment: Invoices will be sent out closer to the convention date. Payment must be made in full by the invoice deadline. Failure to pay on time may result in the space being given to a waitlisted artist. We accept all major credit cards.

Cancellations and Refunds

If you are unable to attend the convention, you must notify the Artist Alley coordinator by email no later than January 15, 2025 in order to receive a full refund. If a replacement is found prior to the convention, you will be refunded once we have received payment from the replacement artist. If no replacement is found, there will be no refund.

Use of Space

Artists and vendors are not permitted to use any electrical outlet without prior approval from the Exhibitors Coordinator. It is acceptable to charge phones. Strictly prohibited items include:

- Laminators and printers
- Computers and laptops

- Stereo equipment and lighting displays

Artists and vendors are not permitted to play any music at their space.

Table displays must be freestanding or secured in a non-damaging way. Displays cannot be secured to the building in any way including (but not limited to) balconies, walls, sinks, and doors. Belongings and merchandise must be stored under the table or behind it.

Table displays are restricted to the 6'x30" table dimensions and the height must not exceed 8 feet. You may bring displays such as garment racks, easels, and shelves but they may only be used if they do not intrude on another artist or vendor's space.

Before leaving the convention, please clean your space of all product and garbage.

Content Regulations

The following items are prohibited to be sold at Tsukino-Con:

- Content violating Canadian copyright or licensing laws including bootleg or plagiarized merchandise
- Illicit or controlled substances
- Food or beverages
- Any pre-assembled products made from art kit, craft kits or similar products
- AI generated art

Tsukino-Con reserves the right to restrict the sale of any product without justification. The sale of any illicit or controlled substances will result not only in expulsion from the convention, but possible action by the University of Victoria and the City of Victoria.

Weapons

- Vendor must be at least 18 years old and provide government issued photo ID.
- Weapons must not be sold to anyone under 18 years old - a physical inspection of government issued ID will be required by the vendor or staff member
- Weapons must be kept in sealed cases until they can be removed from convention grounds.
- Weapons must either be immediately removed from convention grounds following purchase or placed in coat check (free of charge).

Weapons that are considered to be illegal in Victoria, BC or Canada are banned to be sold at the convention. Specific weapons which may not be sold or brought to the convention include:

- Firearms including airsoft, pellet, and paintball guns
- Incendiary devices of any nature

- Tasers
- Leashes or neck restraints
- Gas, smoke, or chemical devices including but not limited to bear or pepper sprays
- Collapsible batons
- Yaoi/Yuri Paddles

Tsukino-Con reserves the right to restrict the sale of any weapon at any time. Failure to abide by these rules will result in expulsion from the convention with no refund. Any attendee or vendor in possession with any item deemed as illegal or prohibited by the convention, University of Victoria, municipal, provincial, or federal law risk having their convention pass revoked and having the proper authorities contacted.

Mature Content

- Artist must be at least 18 years old and provide government issued photo ID.
- Content must not be displayed or sold to anyone under 18 years old - a physical inspection of government issued ID will be required by the artist or a staff member.
- Fan-made doujinshi must clearly indicate the target age and subject matter.

Any artists or vendors who are found to be in violation of these rules will lose their space and will not be refunded. Check with the Artist Alley Coordinator in advance if you're unsure.

Badge Pickup

Arrive at Elliott Building and identify yourself as an "Exhibitor" to be let inside. The Artist Alley Coordinator will be distributing the badges to all of the artists and vendors inside. Please be sure to receive your badge before exiting or re-entering the building to make things smoother.

Safety

Some tables will have spaces in between to act as exits. You may not block these exits. Further, any fire equipment or doorways cannot be blocked. Standing on tables, chairs, or benches to adjust displays is prohibited.

For emergencies - **Call 911 first**, then ask a staff member to page Campus Security and/or First Aid.

Violation of Contract

Damage or failure to abide by Tsukino-Con and University of Victoria rules and regulations may result in fines, warnings, expulsion, and possible action by the City of Victoria. There will be no

refunds given to those who violate the rules. Violations will affect future applications to Tsukino-Con.
